### Samlesbury CE Primary School - Long Term Plan for Religious Education (RE)

- RE should receive at least 5% of class time, which equates to 45 hours per year in KS2 and 36 hours in KS1.
- Between 70% and 80% (31½hrs-36hrs in KS2 and 25¼hrs-29hrs in KS1) of this time will be dedicated to the study of Christianity. These are shown in red text on the long-term plans below.
- Between 20% and 30% of RE teaching time (9hrs-13½hrs in KS2 and 7hrs-10¾hrs in KS1) should be spent looking at world faiths to include study of Buddhism, Hinduism, Islam, Judaism and Sikhism. These are shown in blue text on the long-term plans shown below. Also shown on the plans below are the world faiths explored within each unit.
- Children in the Early Years Foundation Stage should always have access to continuous provision linked to their RE learning and this will contribute towards some of their recommended hours.
- Recommended hours per unit are shown in brackets, however this is intended as a guidance and the length may alter according to pupils' interest and available resources. Where the suggested number of hours includes (x+y), then 'x' is the number of hours for the study of Christianity and 'y' is the number of hours for the study of world faiths.
